NASA seeks to begin construction of telescopes immediately

NASA seeks to begin construction on the first 4 to 6 telescopes without meeting federal requirements to assess cultural and environmental impacts.

The University of Hawaii, who

manages Mauna Kea, has applied for a Conservation District Use Permit (CDUA) to the DLNR on NASA's behalf. Despite 30 years of public opposition to continued desecration of Mauna Kea, UH is proceeding with a

plan that would allow 60 new telescopes to the existing 24.

Tell the Board of Land & Natural Resources to deny the permit. The cultural and spiritual integrity of Mauna Kea must be protected.
